
Activities and Accomplishments

 - Lote4Kids features picture books in over 60 languages.
 - EraBooks Online includes decodable phonics based reading and activities, supporting the work of SPASD's Right to Read Initiative.
 - Transparent Language is a language learning database for beginners and travelers. There is also an English immersion course for those new to English. This track supports various adult literacy, including American citizenship, workforce development, and driving courses.
