6. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- a. Consideration, Discussion and Possible Action on Schematic Design (Christy Monk, FEH Design)
 - a. Monk discussed the changes that have been made to the Schematic Design.
 - b. The atrium and the building square footage was reduced to save 2,100 square feet. Tweaks were made to furniture layouts.
 - c. The updated site plan was discussed. The parking stall count has been slightly reduced, removing 26 parking spaces. The bio retention basin will be reduced as a result. The second parking lot entrance was taken out. As a result, the primary entrance will be widened. The sidewalks were pulled back and landscaping was reworked. A cost cap of \$200,000 was set on the band shell.
 - d. The updated Opinion of Probable Cost was discussed.
 - e. Kevin Johnson spoke about the changes. Nothing has been diminished from an employee or visibility standpoint, and it doesn't compromise any of the core values or goals.
 - f. Project total cost to present to council: \$22,416,034
 - 1. This includes the Community Room atrium access, excludes the smart locker system, and removes credits for the micro grid grant and focus on energy incentive
 - g. The cost if the building system is geothermal would be: \$23,516,034
 - h. Caitlin Stene, City of Sun Prairie Director of Administrative Services, discussed the financial impact with the Library Board.

- 1. The increased cost has no impact on future borrowing for other city projects and it doesn't negatively impact our debt metrics.
- i. MOTION: To approve the design of \$22,416,034 as the base price, and include an alternative with the geothermal option at \$23,516,034.
