## Instructions

How the Adult Summer Reading Program works:

- 1. Read! Read! Read!
- 2. Log your reading time to earn points. (1 point awarded for every 2 hours for up to 15 points.)
- 3. Complete activities to earn points.
- 4. Go to the 'Prize Drawings' on page 10 to dispense your points. (Prize drawings will be held shortly after September 3rd. All prizes must be picked up in person.)
- 5. Complete the Summer Reading Program (for 5 extra points!) by logging at least 30 hours of reading over the summer AND completing the *Big Summer Read: The Book* activity. (Note: "Completing" the program is not necessary to win prizes but it does increase your chances of winning!)

Bonus: You can also earn small prizes for every 30 hours of reading you complete (up to 120 hours)! When you complete 30-hour reading increments, stop by the Welcome Desk to collect a prize.


