General Purpose

Serve on the board to lead the Friends in support of the Sun Prairie Public Library. The board works to maintain a membership interested in the Sun Prairie Public Library; stimulate the use of the library's resources and services; provide volunteer support for the library's programs; raise funds for special library purposes; support and cooperate with the library in developing library services. The purposes, activities, and operations of the Friends are carried out in accordance with the provisions of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Duties

Serve a two-year term, with the following responsibilities:

- 1. Attend regular monthly Board meetings.
- 2. Serve on committees and other volunteer appointments.
- 3. Determine policy and plans/organize activities of the Friends.
- 4. Plan and attend November annual membership meeting.
- 5. Notify President if unable to attend a board meeting.
- 6. Can suggest items for the monthly meeting agenda with approval of Board President and participate in discussing all Board agenda items.

Working Conditions/Time Required

Must attend scheduled board meetings to conduct board business as well as the annual meeting the second week in November. Friends' activities and programs require additional time. May attend City Council meetings for budget support for the library and advocate for other library issues, as required.

The board president or designee will provide a review of the bylaws of the Friends of the Sun Prairie Public Library, parliamentary procedure, organization of the Friends, volunteer handbook and reference manual, and annual reporting requirements for 501 (c) (3) non-profit status.
