#### Summary of projects in progress for 2019.

# Initiative #1 (Facilities & Spaces)

- Finalize Concept Design
  - F4 Concept recommendation from FEH Design has been shared with Council.
  - Based on statistical information from Dane County, SCLS, SPASD and City of Sun Prairie, work with FEH Design to include modified expansion with future branches.
  - Expansion options will be shared with COW on May 21.
- Immediate Facility Issues
  - o Restroom Renovation meetings underway
  - Roof repair contract in process
  - Address possible mold issues
- Additional CIP projects for 2020-2024 include: parking lot rehabilitation, teen space update and automated sorter replacement.
- Roof replacement, HVAC & Boiler replacement and staff restrooms will be addressed as part of the larger expansion project.

### Initiative #2 (Funding & Staffing)

- In 2019, we added two LA I positions in Adult Services and one Page I position in Technical Services.
- \$2,500 was added to the Youth Services Programming 2019 budget.
- Work on potential 2020 Budget Initiatives
  - o Additional LA I and Page I hours to support year-round Sunday Services
  - Elevate Assistant Youth Services Librarian to Youth Services Librarian. This is an entrylevel professional position similar in scope to the current Adult Services Librarian.
- Fundraising Feasibility study for Capital Campaign (2019 budget).
  - After confirming council support for the expansion on May 21, move forward with the feasibility study
- Working currently with Library Strategies to develop capacity for Capital Campaign as well as ongoing funding.
  - Report has been received.
  - o Create a Vision statement for the campaign.
- Madison Community Foundation Grant received \$7500 to enhance services for ELL youth and teens.
- SPPL Foundation \$30,224 will be available for special projects to be identified and discussed with the Library Board.
  - o Tentative projects: Dreambus, Teen Area Update and Welcome Area Update.
- Friends of SPPL- 2019 budget includes \$13,900 for youth and adult programs. An additional \$2000 for art and Spanish Language materials.

#### Initiative #3 (Access)

- DCLS Partnership Dreambus is in place to make stops in Sun Prairie beginning in April.
- Website Redesign New website is live.
- Homebound/Senior Service Working with Colonial View Senior Apartments on outreach.
- Digitization Working on digitizing library documents and photographs to share at the 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration.

- Explore online/digital library cards and application process pending SCLS and KOHA development.
- Explore partnership with SPU to include library card registration information to all new residents.
- Continuing pop-up library visits to Community Schools and Sunshine Supper.

## Initiative #4 (Partnerships)

- Museum Museum is using new exhibit case and will be hosting programs at the library.
- BTP Grants: Collaborative grant and EZ grant funds.
- Library Strategies. Retreat at the end of March with Library Board, Foundation Board, and Friends Board.
